## WARD LAKE 2016 – 2017 Management Buck Criteria

Participation in the management buck program is completely voluntary. Please note the two levels of management buck criteria below.

All broken tines and broken main beams will be counted as true points and measurements will be taken to match the unbroken side.

## 7 Points and Less Management Buck Criteria:

Any 1.5 year old spike with tines 4" and less in length

Any 2.5 year old buck with 6 mainframe points or less

Any 3.5+ year old buck with 7 mainframe points or less

Any buck with 7 mainframe points or less, regardless of age, that are on the management buck shoot list.

Harvesting a buck with 7 points or less that does not qualify under the management buck criteria above will result in the membership losing the ability to harvest anymore management bucks and trophy bucks for the remainder of the current season.

## 8 Points and Greater Management Buck Criteria:

Any 3.5 year old buck that scores less than 115" gross B&C.

Any 4.5 year old buck that scores less than 125" gross B&C.

Any 5.5+ year old buck or older that scores less than 140" gross B&C.

Any buck with 8 mainframe points or greater, regardless of age, that is on the management buck shoot list.

A buck with 8 or more mainframe points that does not meet the management criteria above will be considered a trophy and the penalty for harvest of this deer will coincide with the penalty for harvesting an illegal trophy.
